1. Conference Background

The year 2026 marks the 20th anniversary of the Advances in Arachis through Genomics and Biotechnology (AAGB) conference. Since its inaugural meeting in 2006, AAGB has been successfully held across the globe. It has consistently built a high-level and professional platform for international academic exchange and collaboration among experts and scholars engaged in peanut genomics and biotechnology worldwide, playing an important role in advancing scientific innovation and promoting the sustainable development of the global peanut industry.

To commemorate this important milestone, the 20th Anniversary International Conference on Advances in Arachis through Genomics and Biotechnology (AAGB-2026) will be held in Guangzhou, China, from November 9 to 13, 2026. As an important component of the 2026 Greater Bay Area (Guangdong) Agricultural Science and Technology Forum, the conference will be jointly organized by the Guangdong Academy of Agricultural Sciences (GDAAS) and The Peanut Research Foundation (TPRF), and hosted by the Crops Research Institute (CRI) of GDAAS. As the largest major peanut-producing region in South China, Guangdong boasts an annual peanut planting area of over 5 million mu (approximately 333,000 hectares). With a solid industrial foundation and prominent research strengths, the province provides sound industrial support and an excellent academic environment for the conference.

It is expected that more than 200 experts and scholars from over 30 countries will gather at this event. Through plenary lectures, invited presentations, thematic sessions, young scholar forums and poster exhibitions, participants will conduct in-depth discussions on the latest advances in peanut genomics and biotechnology, further strengthening international scientific exchange and collaboration for the benefit of the global peanut research and industry community.
